It is with a sad and heavy heart that I write to let you know that Jayn Adina Stewart made her transition on Saturday night, the 25<sup>th</sup> of April in Tacoma, WA.

In 1994, Jayn co-founded Soul Support Systems and the Heaven on Earth Community. She lived here in Vermont for two years assisting us to create the foundation of our organization, our community and our work. Her input was instrumental in shaping the curriculum of our experiential workshops and classes. Jayn helped to clarify our vision and to assist in the development of the principles and tenets that we teach today.

Where Jayn really shone was in bringing the words and understanding of The Ones With No Names and other spiritual guides to all of us. She edited *I Remember Union, Sunlight on Water, Honoring Your Child's Spirit, Cynthia's Promise, Heartful Living, The Light Magnificent and the Power of Grace, Birthing Your Child's Soul in Light* and co-wrote *Hearts of the Village*. She has just completed a compilation of messages from the Great Mother called: *The Great Mother Speaks: Core Teachings from Our Earth Mother*, which will be available soon.

As Educational Coordinator, Jayn and her committee completed the details for a new program to reflect a focus on the heart, the soul and the field for those starting out on their spiritual path.

Jayn's dream was to create a School for the Soul gleaned from 34 years of messages from The Ones With No Names, John Henry, William Marshal and other spiritual guides. Her strong intention was to ground the wisdom of heaven here on Earth, and she had just begun to vision and plan that curriculum.

Another dream was to create an epic film of *I Remember Union*. To support this vision, our community has established a fund in Jayn's name for the pre-pre-production of the film. You can donate to Soul Support and receive a deduction through our 501C3.

We send sincere condolences and blessings to Jayn's children, Liz Williams and family; Kate Landy and family and Matt Zopf's family. We hope they will join us as we celebrate Jayn's life on Sunday at 2 PM eastern via a Zoom Conference call. We will begin and end in silence. Due to the number of anticipated attendees, we will be recording the service for those who may be unable to attend in person.

In the 32 years that Jayn was my co-creator, co-conspirator, co-teacher/facilitator, editor, mentor and friend, she gave 100% of herself, her wisdom and strength. She was a beautiful woman of character and discernment that was trustworthy, genuine and kind. I know we will all miss her loveliness, her smile, her warmth and her grace.

We all so appreciate the dear, soft, open, enfolding way that Jayn wove our pieces together and created a fabric of Light and Union between us. We each have a deep place within that she gently touched, drawing out our Essence with her knowing and presence. Without words she supported our dreams and our intentions.

I send Miss Jayn my deepest gratitude for sharing herself, her gifts, her heart, and her soul with me and with all of us. She was a rare beacon, lighting up the world wherever she went. What a journey it has been! My heart reaches out to hold hers as she journeys to the place where all is Light.
